

Fabrications Editors' Report to the SAHANZ AGM  
23 June 2009

2008 ISSUES

The Editors saw two issues into press at the end of 2008, the first drawn from a session at the 61<sup>st</sup> Annual Meeting of the Society of Architectural Historians in April 2008, the second an open issue in preparation since the end of 2007.

18, no. 1 (June 2008):

Papers (5) by Julie Willis & Philip Goad, Leonie Matthews, Paul Walker, Robin Skinner, Paul Memmott & James Davidson, and an obituary for George Tibbits (SAHANZ Life Member); 7 book reviews; 137pp; nett cost (costs less subs income to UQP) A\$3356.53. 7 papers submitted for the SAH session, 5 published.

18, no. 2 (December 2008):

Papers (5) by Tristan Guilloux, Gevork Hartoonian, Harriet Edquist, David Nichols and Erik Ghenoïu; 5 book reviews; 135pp; nett cost A\$2357.08. 10 papers submitted for this issue, 5 published.

FAST-IP

Following discussions at the SAH meeting in Cincinnati, the Editors and Editorial Board Chair successfully submitted a proposal for *Fabrications* to join the Federation of Architectural Studies Independent Publications, coordinated by Jorge Otero-Pailos and Mark Jarzombek. This increases visibility in like journals, and puts a selected paper from the year's issues into contention for an annual essay prize.

2009 ISSUES

Papers for the mid-year issue (19, no. 1) have moved into line-editing and will shortly be ready for publication. Success rate for the open issue is consistent with last year's open issue, with 12 papers considered and 8 proceeding into the issue. Preparations are underway to publish a special issue of *Fabrications* drawn from papers presented at the symposium *Social Theory and Historiography in the Writing of Asian Architecture* (Melbourne University, September 2008). Anoma Pieris will work alongside Paul Walker as a Guest Editor on this issue, nominally December 2009 (19, no. 2).

EDITORIAL PERSONNEL

In September 2008 Andrew Leach advised Paul Walker and John Macarthur that he would not complete his editorial term, finishing with 19, no. 1 (June 2009) rather than 19, no. 2 (December 2009).
